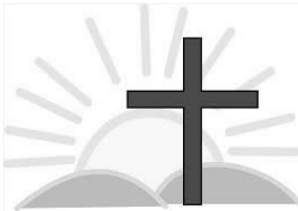


SERVICES AT ST. CUTHBERT'S CHURCH
